


What is PBIS?

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a multi-tiered framework for creating and maintaining a positive school climate by teaching and acknowledging clear behavior expectations. At Rowland Elementary, our behavior expectations are **PRIDE: Problem Solving, Respect/Responsibility, Integrity, Determination, and Empathy**.

Schools scoring at 70% or higher on the TFI are considered effective and more likely to see outcomes.</p> <p>Our implementation data revealed that one of our strengths is our school-wide systems that are in place. One focus area for the 24-25 school year will be to keep staff and community members informed of PBIS data, practices and upcoming PBIS related activities.</p> |
